

RESOLUTION NO. 07-03

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WESTERN RIVERSIDE COUNTY REGIONAL CONSERVATION AUTHORITY APPROVING A SUBGRANT FROM THE WILDLIFE CONSERVATION BOARD FOR THE WILLIAMS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Robert Bruce Williams has offered for the sum of \$500,000 property located south of Tule Peak Road, within Assessor Parcel Number 580-340-004, in the Anza Valley area;

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2007, the Board of Directors of the Western Riverside County Regional Conservation Authority authorized the acquisition of the subject property and approved the expenditure of \$250,000 of RCA MSHCP Fees as a match for a grant from the Wildlife Conservation Board;

WHEREAS, on May 24, 2007 the Wildlife Conservation Board will consider approving a subgrant agreement in the amount of \$250,000 to assist the Western Riverside County Regional Conservation Authority in acquiring the subject property;

WHEREAS, the Western Riverside County Regional Conservation Authority is willing to accept the subgrant from the Wildlife Conservation Board; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance of this subgrant will assist the Western Riverside County Regional Conservation Authority in providing open space for preservation of wildlife and plant life;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Directors of the Western Riverside County Regional Conservation Authority as follows:

1. That the Board of Directors of the Western Riverside County Regional Conservation Authority hereby finds and declares that the above recitals are true and correct.

2. That the Board of Directors of the Western Riverside County Regional Conservation Authority approves a subgrant agreement from the Wildlife Conservation Board for the sum of \$250,000 to assist in the acquisition of real property, Assessor Parcel Number 580-340-004, in the Anza Valley area for habitat conservation.


3. That the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Western Riverside County Regional Conservation Authority is authorized to execute the documents necessary to accept the grant from the Wildlife Conservation Board.
