# Mud Nama

- Native to California and parts of northern Mexico
- In the boraginaceae family
- Found in marshes swamps and vernal wetlands
- Blooming period is from January to July
- Can be used as a vernal pool indicator species
- In the plan area it can be found in the San Jacinto River

# Monitoring and Management

- Include within the MSHCP Conservation Area two of the three known occurrences of the species
- Include at least 7,050 acres of suitable habitat
- Include within the MSHCP Conservation area the floodplain along the San Jacinto River
