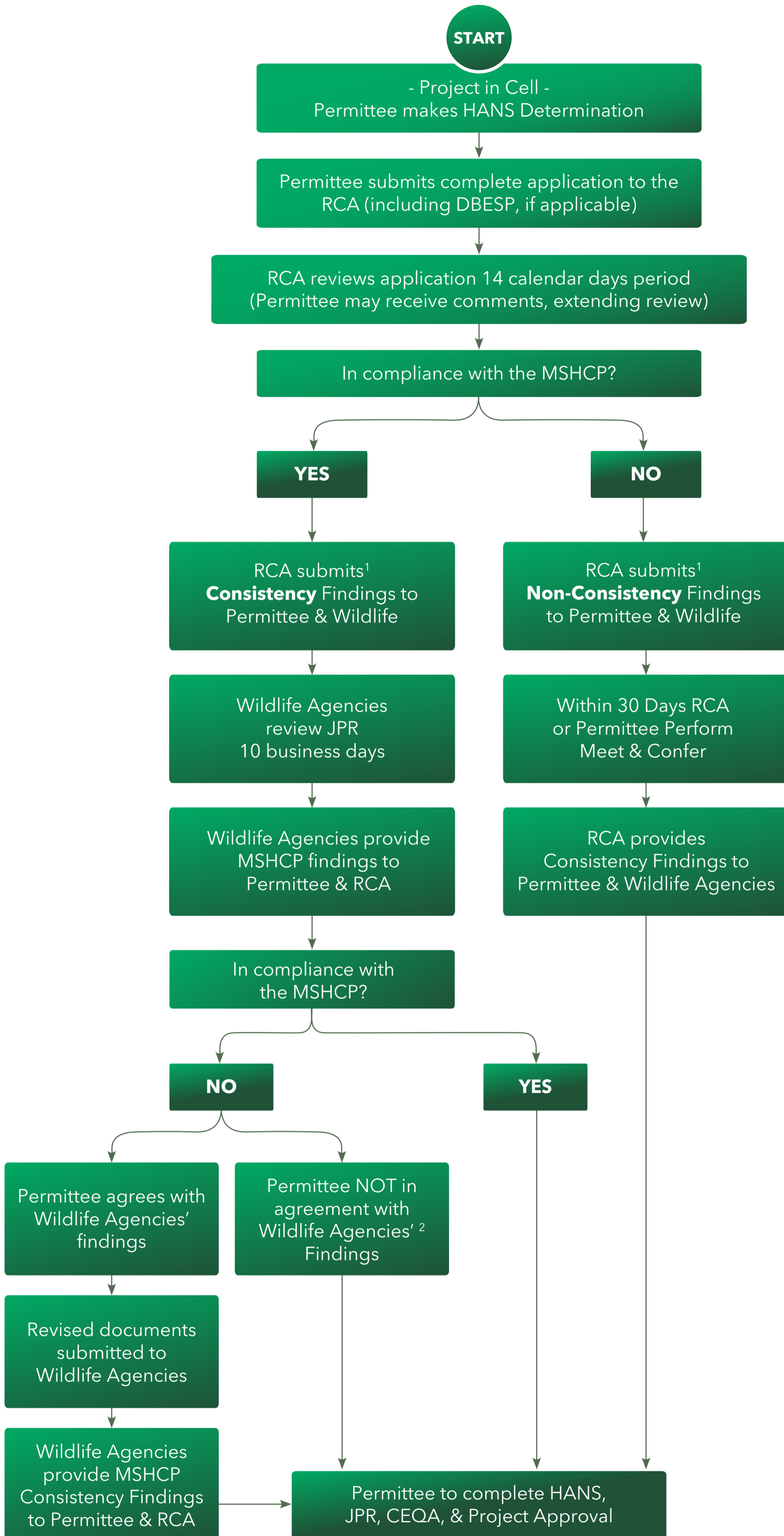


# JOINT PROJECT REVIEW (JPR) PROCESS



<sup>1</sup>=Findings include all project documentation including a DBESP (Determination of Biologically Equivalent or Superior Preservation) Report, if applicable. For the DBESP, the Wildlife Agencies have 60 calendar days to review and provide comments to the Permittee. The Permittee determines whether additional revisions to the project occurs in order to meet concurrence with the Wildlife Agencies on the DBESP.

<sup>2</sup>=Wildlife Agencies can request an Informal Meet and Confer with Permittee to address inconsistency finding.
