

# EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MINUTES

### 1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the Western Riverside County Regional Conservation Authority Executive Committee was called to order by Vice Chairman Ingram at 12:20 p.m., Wednesday, December 20, 2017, in the RCA Conference Room, 3403 Tenth Street, Suite 320, Riverside, California, 92501.

### 3. PUBLIC COMMENTS

### 4. COMMITTEE MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENTS

Vice Chairman Ingram called for Committee Member announcements. Board Member Edwards thanked staff for their help on the Altair project in the City of Temecula. The project was approved by Temecula City Council by a 4-1 vote. Board Member Hewitt announced that on January 1, 2018, the City of Calimesa will be taking over the fire station, and the first City of Calimesa Fire Department will be in existence. The city will employ 18 fire staff members.

# 7. WESTERN RIVERSIDE COUNTY MSHCP FEE COLLECTION REPORT FOR OCTOBER 2017

Honey Bernas, Director of Administrative Services, reported that for the month of November 2017, the total fee collection receipts were \$1,603,979.

### 8. MID YEAR REVIEW RECURRING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACTS

Honey Bernas, Director of Administrative Services, reported that Board of Directors directed staff to agendize a midyear review of RCA's recurring professional services contracts. She referred to the listed eight contracts on page two of the staff report and gave a brief overview of each consultant contract. Vice Chairman Ingram asked if there would be a cost increase in any upcoming contract. Honey Bernas replied that

she would do her diligence in RCA not incurring any significant cost increases. Vice Chairman Ingram recommended that rather than having a large increase at the end of a contract term, that a small increase, five to ten percent increase or a not to exceed figure of said percentage, staff has the authority to approve and not have to schedule contract for approval before the Board of Directors. He asked if all Executive Committee Members present were in agreement with this change. They all agreed. Vice Chairman Ingram further asked if the Executive Director was in agreement with this change. Charles Landry answered, "Yes." Vice Chairman Ingram asked if any Executive Committee members had questions. There were no questions.

9. INTRODUCTION OF RESOLUTION NO. 2017-XXX, RESOLUTION NO. 2017-XXX RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WESTERN RIVERSIDE COUNTY REGIONAL CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AMENDING ARTICLE IV.E OF ITS BYLAWS WITH REGARD TO COMPENSATION

Honey Bernas, Director of Administrative Services, presented this resolution. This is a request to amend RCA's Bylaws to allow for additional meeting attendance compensation for Chairperson, Vice Chairperson and Past Chairperson in an amount not to exceed \$800.00 per month. She explained that the numerous business meetings an officer is called upon to attend, with Member Agencies, when traveling to Washington, D.C., and Sacramento to meet with legislatures, their staff and committee members on various projects that RCA is involved with. At present, the bylaws only allow for four meetings a month. Charlie Landry explained that there are other Board Members who have been called upon to attend several business meetings on RCA's behalf, yet this amendment will only affects the three officers. The officers' participation has been extremely beneficial to RCA.

The Executive Committee discussed the proposed revisions and directed staff to research the matter and report back to the Executive Committee.
